

SET FOR LIFE NEWSPAPER PROMOTION

Terms & Conditions

1. **Acceptance of Terms and Conditions:** Instructions and information on how to enter the promotion form part of these terms and conditions, and entry into the promotion is deemed acceptance of these terms and conditions.
2. **Promoter:** The promoter is Tatts Lotteries SA Pty Ltd ACN 146 245 007 acting as master agent for the Lotteries Commission of South Australia of Level 1, 26 Franklin Street, Adelaide, SA 5000, Australia phone 131868 (**Promoter**). The Promoter and its related companies are referred to as the **Promoter Group**.
3. **Participating Outlets:** This promotion is only available from the Promoter's retail outlets that also stock News Corp Australia Pty Limited publications.
4. **Promotion Period:** Entry to the promotion is open from 00.00 15 May 2016 until 23.59 Saturday 21 May 2016 (**Promotion Period**)
5. **Eligibility:** Entry to the promotion is free and is open to all customers aged 18 years and over.
6. **How to qualify:** To qualify for this promotion a customer must purchase a Set for Life game entry for a Set for Life draw starting from the day of purchase from any Participating Outlet during the Promotion Period (**Qualifying Transaction**). 7. **Complimentary Newspaper:** Each customer who makes a Qualifying Transaction will be issued with a complimentary copy of that day's Adelaide Advertiser or the Sunday Mail while stocks last. Other daily News Corp titles, including The Australian, are not included in this promotion. The Complimentary Newspaper must be redeemed at the time of purchase.
8. **Ticket Cancellations:** Any customer who cancels a qualifying Set for Life game entry must either return the Complimentary Newspaper or pay the Participating Outlet the recommended retail price of the Newspaper which they have previously redeemed as a complimentary product.
