What is Keno Coin Toss?

Keno Coin Toss is a feature played as part of the regular Keno draw of 20 numbers. With Keno Coin Toss, you pick 'Heads', 'Tails' or 'Evens' based on where you think the majority of the numbers drawn will be placed.

Heads 11 or more of the 20 numbers in the range 1 to 40.

Tails 11 or more of the 20 numbers in the range 41 to 80.

Evens Equal numbers in each range.

How much can I win?

Prize is based on a \$1 entry.



How to play Keno Coin Toss

Keno Coin Toss* can be played on its own or with Keno. There are two ways to play: 'Standard' or 'Run'.




Standard.

On a regular Single Keno coupon, mark your selection (or an Easi-Pick) for your chosen draws, along with the amount you wish to play per game. This is a Standard entry.

A Standard Coin Toss draw may also be played by making the applicable selections on either:

- a Keno Coin Toss coupon for up to 5 consecutive draws, or on
- a Keno Combo coupon.

Heads = More numbers drawn in the range 1 to 40
Evens = Equal numbers in each range 1 to 40 and 41 to 80
Tails = More numbers drawn in the range 41 to 80

Run.

Or mark the RUN box** and your selections (or ask for an Easi-Pick) to run over 2 to 5 consecutive draws and the dollar value per game. In the event of a RUN win, the prize is automatically invested into the next draw.

To win a RUN, all selections of 'Heads', 'Tails' or 'Evens' must be correctly matched.

*Keno Coin Toss is only available at SA Lotteries agencies.

** Available on Keno Coin Toss coupon only.
